

GETTYSBURG FIELD TRIP

This is an optional activity for any who are interested and will incur an additional \$45 fee per attendee. The cost of the Gettysburg Teacher Training includes a National Defense University-trained docent for the entire battlefield tour, a study guide, continental breakfast, lunch, and transportation. Meet at Annapolis EP Church, depart 7:00 a.m. and return at 6:00 p.m. on Monday, July 25, 2011.

The purpose of the day is to help teachers bring history to life for students, plan field trips, use history to drive home character and leadership with students, and guide students to view history in terms of motivation, context, and outcomes, all with a biblical worldview.

LUNCH

Lunch is provided by Rockbridge Academy on Tuesday, July 26th to encourage fellowship and meet Rockbridge Academy teachers. Training attendees should plan to travel a short distance for lunch Wednesday through Friday. There are several fast-food and eat-in restaurants within 5 minutes of the training facility.

DIRECTIONS FROM POINTS NORTH AND WEST:

Baltimore Beltway, I-695, to I-97 South. Keep left at the fork approaching US-50 and follow signs for US-50 East toward Annapolis/Bay Bridge. Merge onto US-50 East. Follow to Exit 24A, and as the exit ramp splits, stay left. At the stop light at the bottom of the ramp, turn left onto Rowe Blvd. At the next light, turn right onto N. Bestgate Road. Follow the road to the stop sign. Annapolis EP Church is on the far left corner.

DIRECTIONS FROM POINTS SOUTH AND WEST:

I-95 North to Washington Beltway, toward Baltimore. Take Exit 19A, US-50 toward Annapolis. Take Exit 24A, and as the exit ramp splits, stay left. At the stop light at the bottom of the ramp, turn left onto Rowe Blvd. At the next light, turn right onto N. Bestgate Road. Follow the road to the stop sign. Annapolis EP Church is on the far left corner.

DIRECTIONS FROM POINTS EAST:

US-50 West toward Washington, D.C. Merge onto Rowe Blvd via Exit 24B. At the next light, turn right onto N. Bestgate Road. Follow the road to the stop sign. Annapolis EP Church is on the far left corner.

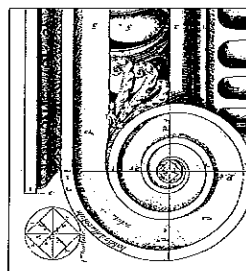

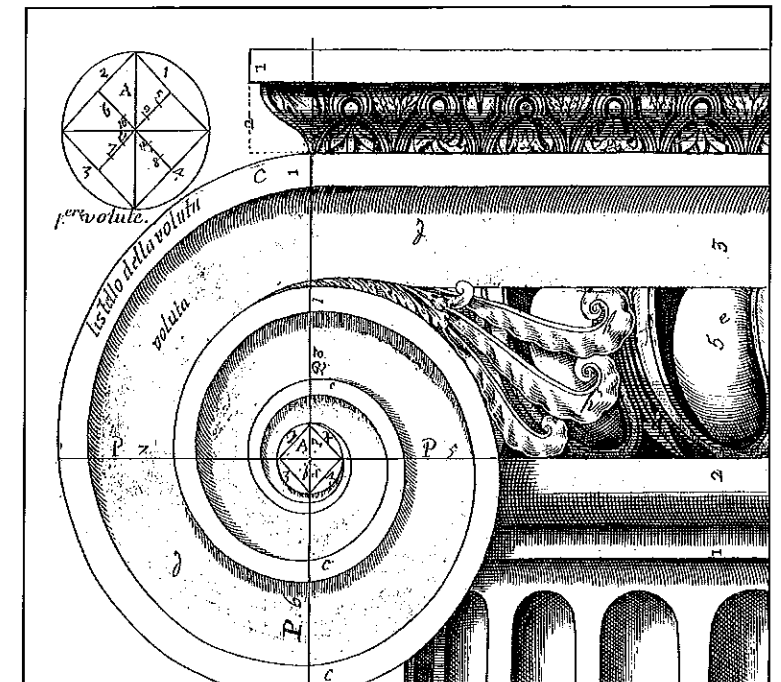

The teacher training seminar will be held at Evangelical Presbyterian Church of Annapolis ("Annapolis EP"), 710 Ridgely Avenue, Annapolis, MD 21401. Annapolis EP is located at the intersection of Wilson Road and Ridgely Avenue just north of Route 50, near the Rowe Boulevard exit. The area is rich in historical and cultural activities, with Washington, D.C., and the city of Baltimore within a short driving distance.

WHEN

July 25-29, 2011. Monday, July 25th is an *optional* teacher training field trip to Gettysburg National Military Battlefield Park. Formal teacher training starts at Annapolis EP Church on Tuesday, July 26th. Please arrive by 8:30 a.m. on Tuesday to pick up materials. The seminars normally run from 7:50 or 8:50 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. The Friday session will be dismissed at lunch.
